Her doctorate in theology is from the Gregorian University in Rome. She has previously lectured and worked in Peru, Italy, and Mexico. During her time in Rome she was also Responsible for the Section on Women's Issues in the Vatican. She is currently Lecturer in Theology at Good Shepherd Theological College, Auckland.
